On this the 1st day of October, 2020, the Grand Jury of the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana, charges that Kasha Domingue, at and in the Parish, District and State aforesaid, committed the offenses of Illegal Use of Weapons or Dangerous Instrumentalities and Aggravated Second Degree Battery, violating Louisiana Revised Statutes 14:34.7 and 14:94.B, in that:

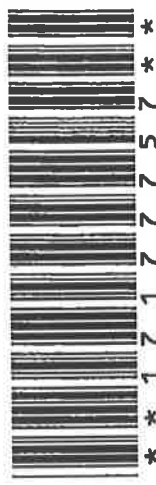
Count 1: on or about July 10, 2018, she committed a battery with a dangerous weapon upon Larry Clifton Scott Dilley and intentionally inflicting serious bodily injury;

Count 2: on or about July 10, 2018, she intentionally and in a criminally negligent manner discharged a firearm in a place where it was foreseeable that it might have resulted in death or great bodily harm to a human being.
