I, Samuel Stafford , with the Baton Rouge Police Department, certify under oath based on the information outlined below, that there is probable cause to believe ISAAH MARSHALL on or about did commit:

I Count of RS14:202.1--Residential Contractor Fraud-- (FELONY)

within this State and Parish at: and the jurisdiction of the 19TH Judicial District Court, contrary to the form of the statutes of the State of Louisiana in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the same, in that the following did occur:

The complainant advised that her residence located at 533 Chesterfield Dr. Baton Rouge, Louisiana was affected by the flood of 2016. The complainant advised she hired a contractor company listed as Sable International DBA (Doing business as) Changing Lives Construction Company. The complainant advised the contract was for \$86,100.00 and the work began in March of 2017. The complainant advised during the process she issued many checks to the ACCUSED that totaled \$82,964.00. The complainant advised the ACCUSED demanded more funds because of other problems that occurred along the rebuilding process. The complainant advised the ACCUSED did not want to go through the process of acquiring more funds. The complainant advised the ACCUSED left the residence in July of 2017 and has not been back since. AFFIANT advise the contractor license that was presented to the complainant does not belong to the ACCUSED, but to a person he used to work for in New Orleans. AFFIANT contacted the license holder of Changing Lives Construction Company LLC in New Orleans and learned that he did not know anything about the ACCUSED using his license. AFFIANT also advises that the license that the ACCUSED used is only for commercial use only and not residential. AFFIANT learned that the ACCUSED went to the website of Louisiana License Board and printed out the license that belong to Changing Lives Construction Company and used

this as his own to persuade the complainant. AFFIANT contacted the Louisiana License Board and was advised that Sable International does not obtain any license for contract work as well.

Probable cause are based on complainant's statements and evidence collected through an investigation. AFFIANT respectfully requests the courts to issue a warrant for the ACCUSED.
